Brazil is one of the BRICs, one of the emerging countries which strive for a better, more active insertion in the international system, both politically and economically. The Ambassador of Brazil to the Netherlands will describe current economic and social policies in Brazil, including Brazil's response to the financial crisis, as well as prospects for the future. Brazil's long standing relationship to the Netherlands will also be mentioned.

Ambassador José A. Denot Medeiros, a career diplomat, is at The Hague since May last year. Before, he held different diplomatic Posts: Ambassador to Germany, to the Latin-American integration movement in Montevideo and to Suriname. He was Under-Secretary at the Foreign Ministry and held different Posts in the Ministry of Economy, Finance and Planning in the early nineties.
